Cookies Policy

We understand that your privacy is important to you and that you care about how information relating to your use of this website is collected and used. We respect the privacy of everyone who visits this website: <https://www.lynleaweststudio.com/> ("Our Site").

Please read this Cookies Policy carefully and ensure that you understand it. This Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how We use them on Our Site, and the choices available to you in relation to them.

1. Definition and Interpretation

In this Policy the following terms shall have the following meanings:

"Cookie"	means a small text file placed on your computer or device by Our Site when you visit certain parts of Our Site and/or when you use certain features of Our Site. Details of the Cookies used by Our Site are set out in section 12, below;
"Cookie Law"	means the relevant parts of the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003;
"Data Protection Legislation"	means all applicable legislation in force from time to time in the United Kingdom applicable to data protection and privacy including, but not limited to, the UK GDPR; the Data Protection Act 2018 (and regulations made thereunder); the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2003 as amended and the Data (Use and Access) Act 2025;
"Personal Data"	means any and all data that relates to an identifiable person who can be directly or indirectly identified from that data. In this case, it means Personal Data that you give to Us via Our Site. This definition shall, where applicable, incorporate the definitions provided in the Data Protection Legislation; and
"We/Us/Our"	means Lynlea West Studio Ltd a company registered in England under company number 14272079 with a registered office address of 169 Landells Road, London, SE22 9PN.

2. Information About Us

3. What Does This Policy Cover?

This Cookies Policy applies only to your use of Our Site and to information collected through cookies and similar technologies used on Our Site. Our Site may contain links to other websites. Please note that We have no control over the cookies, technologies, or data practices of other websites and We recommend that you check the relevant cookie and privacy policies of those websites before using them

4. Our Use Of Cookies

a. Our Site may place and access certain first party Cookies on your computer or device. First party Cookies are those placed directly by Us and are used only by Us. We use Cookies to facilitate and improve your experience of Our Site and to provide and improve Our services. We have carefully chosen these Cookies and have taken steps to ensure that your privacy and Personal Data is protected and respected at all times.

b. All Cookies used by and on Our Site are used in accordance with current Cookie Law. We may use some or all of the following types of Cookie:

i. **Strictly Necessary Cookies**

A Cookie falls into this category if it is essential to the operation of Our Site, supporting functions such as logging in, your shopping basket, and payment transactions.

ii. **Analytics Cookies**

It is important for us to understand how you use Our Site, for example, how efficiently you navigate around it and which features you interact with: Where permitted by law, We may use certain analytics cookies that help Us gather this information without requiring your consent. These cookies are used solely to improve the performance and usability of Our Site and do not collect information that identifies you personally. Where analytics cookies are used for any other purpose or involve tracking, We will always request your consent.

iii. **Functionality Cookies**

Functionality Cookies enable Us to provide additional functions to you on Our Site such as personalisation and remembering your saved preferences. Some functionality Cookies may also be strictly necessary Cookies, but not all necessarily fall into that category.

iv. **Targeting Cookies**

It is important for Us to know when and how often you visit Our Site, and which parts of it you have used (including which pages you have visited and which links you have visited). As with analytics Cookies, this information helps us to better understand you and, in turn, to make Our Site and advertising more relevant to your interests.

v. **Persistent Cookies**

Any of the above types of Cookie may be a persistent Cookie. Persistent Cookies are those which remain on your computer or device for a predetermined period and are

activated each time you visit Our Site.

vi. Session Cookies

Any of the above types of Cookie may be a session Cookie. Session Cookies are temporary and only remain on your computer or device from the point at which you visit Our Site until you close your browser. Session Cookies are deleted when you close your browser.

- b. Certain features of Our Site depend on Cookies to function. Cookie Law deems these Cookies to be "strictly necessary". Your consent will not be sought to place these Cookies, but it is still important that you are aware of them. You may still block these Cookies by changing your internet browser's settings as detailed below in section 14.d, but please be aware that Our Site may not work properly if you do so. We have taken great care to ensure that your privacy is not at risk by allowing them.
- c. The following first, third party and analytics Cookies may be placed on your computer or device:

ssr-caching	The ssr-caching cookie is set by WIX and indicates how a site was rendered.	Necessary
XSRF-TOKEN	This cookie enhances visitor browsing security by preventing cross-site request forgery.	Necessary
hs	Wix platform sets this cookie for security purposes.	Necessary
svSession	Wix platform sets this cookie to identify unique visitors and track a visitor's session on a site.	Necessary
bSession	Wix set this cookie in context with load balancing to improve user experience.	Necessary
_wixAB3	The _wixAB3 cookie is used by the hosting provider at the start of a session. It collects information on website traffic, duration and location.	Necessary
fedops.logger.sessionId	Tracking session errors and issues (resilience)	Necessary
mpaSessionId	session storage identifier used to track a user's current visit	Session
client-session-bind	Cookie for API protection	Necessary

- d. In addition to the controls that We provide, you can choose to enable or disable Cookies in your internet browser. Most internet browsers also enable you to choose whether you wish to disable all cookies or only third-party cookies. By default, most internet browsers accept Cookies but this can be changed. For further details, please consult the help menu in your internet browser or the documentation that came with your device.
- e. You can choose to delete Cookies on your computer or device at any time, however you may lose any information that enables you to access Our Site more quickly and efficiently including, but not limited to, login and personalisation settings.

- f. It is recommended that you keep your internet browser and operating system up-to-date and that you consult the help and guidance provided by the developer of your internet browser and manufacturer of your computer or device if you are unsure about adjusting your privacy settings.
